### The Monkey Bar Mission

Every time we headed to Vicker's Park this past summer, you insisted on taking a try at the monkey bars. Try as you might though, you just could not get the hang of doing it on your own. It was something you wanted so badly too, and even questioned why you were having such a hard time whereas kids that were younger than you could do it no problem. Perhaps it may be due to your lack of upper body strength on your one side, or it could merely just be the fear of letting go...and falling. Always know, that just like with everything else in life, we'll be there by your side for as long as you need us. To guide you, protect you, offer support, and pick you up whenever you may fall down. We love you sweetheart, and remember, there's no need to let go before you're ready. All in good time...



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Step 2 - Trim 1/4" of all four sides of the white cardstock, computer generate title and journaling and print. If you don't have access to a wide format printer, trim at the 8 1/2" mark (as illustrated by the dotted line) and print using a standard printer.

The seam will be hidden with a strip of patterned paper within the next 2 steps. Mount onto black cardstock, leaving an even border on all edges.

Step 3 - Cut strips from patterned papers as shown. Trim to the same length as the white cardstock.



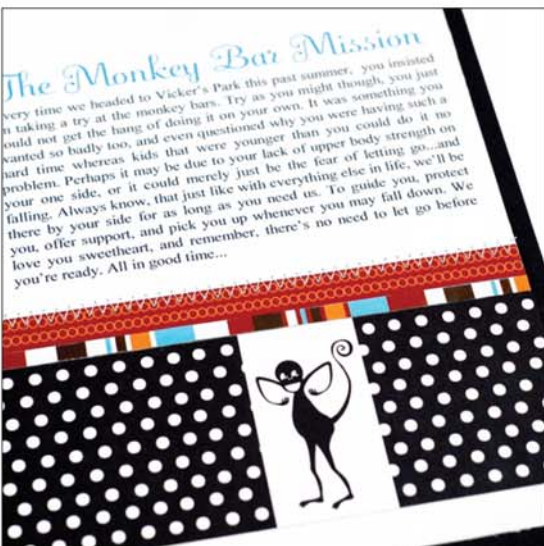
Step 4 - Adhere strips of patterned paper to the white background as shown.



Step 5 - Use scraps of both black and white cardstock, along with a circle and scalloped circle punch to further embellish the chipboard accent. Assemble and adhere to layout as shown.



Step 6 - Machine stitch at seam as shown. (optional)



Step 7 - Adhere photo, and embellish by randomly adhering brads to the dot pattern of the patterned paper.
